noun: happiness

definition: showing pleasure and contentment

I just got a new job. I am so happy!

Afraid/scared/frightened

noun: fear

definition: you are worried about your health and safety because something is dangerous

I am afraid of spiders.

I'm so scared that someone is going to rob my house while I'm on holiday.

Sad

noun: sadness

definition: feeling unhappy

My grandma died. I am so sad.

Amused

noun: amusement

definition: you think something is

funny/entertaining

The children were so amused while watching the dog chase the cat.

Bored

noun: boredom

definition: you are not happy because there is

nothing interesting to do

I've been waiting for my train for 30 minutes. I am

so bored.

Confident

noun: confidence

definition: you feel sure of yourself

My job interview went very well. I am confident

that I will get the job.

Suspicious

noun: suspicion

definition: you think you cannot trust something

My boyfriend keeps working late. I'm a bit suspicious. There might be another woman.

Anxious

noun: anxiety

definition: you feel nervous and worried about

something

Today I get the results from my blood test so I'm

feeling a bit anxious.

Surprised

noun: surprise

definition: you didn't expect something, you feel

shocked

I was so surprised to see that my husband had

cleaned the entire kitchen!

Curious

noun: curiosity

definition: you are interested and want to discover

more information

I'm really curious who is going to be promoted

next. Do you think it's Jim?

Envious

noun: envy

definition: you want what someone else has

I'm so envious of your new house. It's beautiful.

Jealous

noun: jealousy

definition: you have negative feelings because

someone else has something you want

I think Mary is jealous of you because you are

richer and more beautiful.

Miserable

noun: misery

definition: you feel unhappy and uncomfortable

I'm absolutely miserable! It's raining, I'm cold, and

I'm hungry!

Confused

noun: confusion

definition: you don't understand something

I am so confused. I don't understand the difference between the past simple and present perfect.

Angry

noun: anger

definition: you feel very negative and may become aggressive

I can't believe you broke my laptop! I am so angry.

Ashamed

noun: shame

definition: to feel deeply embarrassed and guilty

In front of everyone, I told my mom that I didn't love her. Why did I do that? I'm so ashamed.

Indifferent

noun: indifference

definition: you are not interested in something,

you don't really care

I'm indifferent to politics. I don't really care about the elections.

Determined

noun: determination

definition: you feel very strongly about a goal

I am so determined to lose 5 kilos. I will do this before summer!

Depressed

noun: depression

definition: you are deeply unhappy for long

periods of time

After my son was born, I was depressed for six months. I didn't even want to get out of bed.

Enraged

noun: rage

definition: extremely angry

My father was enraged when he found out that I had used his credit card to get a tattoo.

Interested

noun: interest

definition: you want to discover more information

on something you like

I'm interested in learning Italian. Do you know anyplace that has Italian courses?

Shy

noun: shyness

definition: you are uncomfortable in front of other

people

I don't like going to parties. I'm really shy so it's difficult for me to speak in front of other people.

Hopeful

noun: hope

definition: you think very positively about

something in the future

I'm hopeful that our business will do better next

month.

Stubborn

noun: stubbornness

definition: you are not willing to change

My wife is so stubborn. She refuses to get her eyes checked, even though she knows she needs glasses.

Guilty

noun: guilt

definition: you feel bad because you know you

have done something wrong

I forgot to go to my daughter's tennis match. I feel so guilty. I promised her that I would go, but I

didn't.

Embarrassed

noun: embarrassment

definition: you feel foolish/stupid in front of other

people

In the middle of the business meeting, someone had to tell me that I had spinach stuck in my teeth. I felt so embarrassed.

Disgusted

noun: disgust

definition: you think something is gross

I was so disgusted when my cat dragged a dead rabbit into the house.

Proud

noun: pride

definition: you feel very good about your actions

I'm so proud that I passed the IELTS exam with a 7!

Ecstatic

noun: ecstasy

definition: extremely happy

Wow, you should have seen Daniel when he found out he got the promotion. He was ecstatic.

Lonely

noun: loneliness

definition: you feel sad because you are alone

I know university is supposed to be exciting, but I feel so lonely without my parents.

Frustrated

noun: frustration

definition: you feel anger because something isn't happening the way you want it to

I've been on the phone all morning with this client and they keep disagreeing with me. I am so frustrated with them.

Smug

noun: smugness

definition: you feel proud in a negative way

I hate how smug Sarah is. I know she's the boss' favourite, but she is just so... smug about it.

Relieved

noun: relief

definition: you feel happy because something negative is actually positive

I am so relieved I passed the exam. Phew! I seriously thought I was going to fail.

Shocked

noun: shock

definition: extremely surprised What? You're pregnant again? I'm shocked! You just had a baby two months ago!

Skeptical/sceptical

noun: skepticism/scepticism

definition: you doubt whether something is true

or not

I'm sceptical of horoscopes, but sometimes it's creepy how accurate they are.
